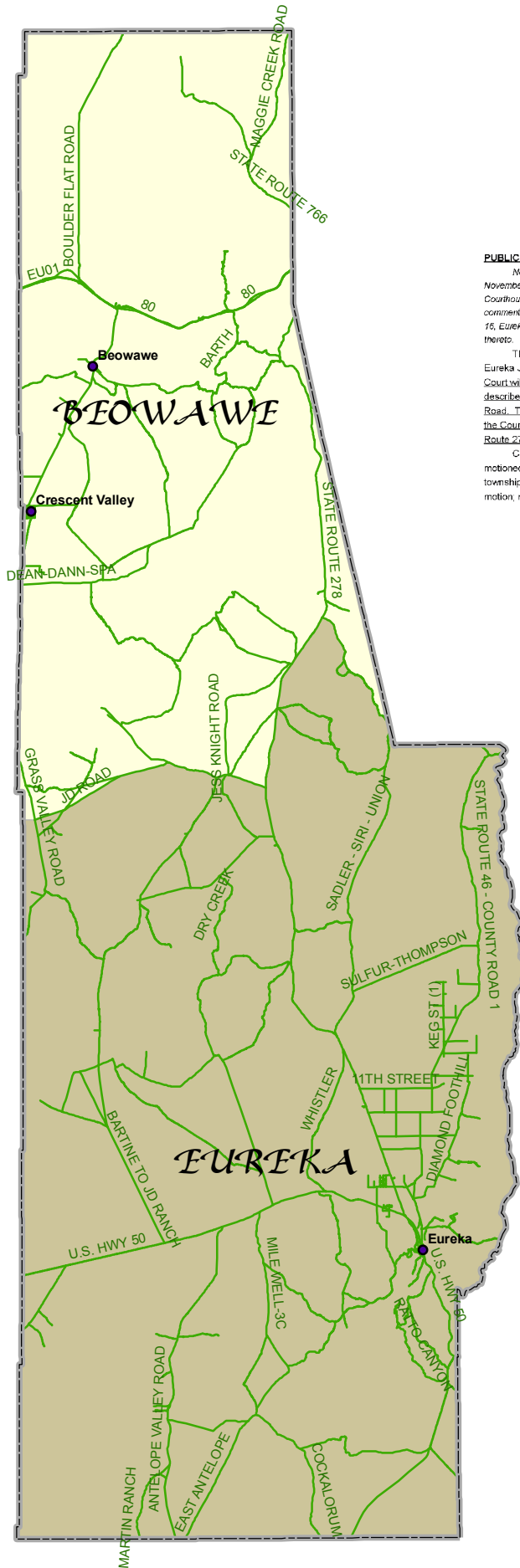
Portion of 11-06-2007 – Eureka County Commissioner Meeting:

PUBLIC HEARING – ADDITION OF TITLE 16 TO EUREKA COUNTY CODE

Notice was given that the Board of Eureka County Commissioners would hold a public hearing on November 6, 2007, beginning at 2:00 p.m. in the Eureka County Commissioners' chambers in the County Courthouse, at 10 S. Main Street in Eureka, Nevada. The reason for said hearing was to invite public comments and take action on a proposed ordinance adding a new title to the 2006 Eureka County Code, Title 16, Eureka County Justice Courts, defining the township boundaries and other matters properly relating thereto.

The ordinance will define the boundaries and identify two justice courts in Eureka County, Eureka Justice Court and Beowawe Justice Court. The township boundary for the Eureka Justice Court will be from the southern boundary of the County, north to the east/west dividing line described by the JD Ranch Road, north along State Route 278, then east along the Union Pass Road. The township boundary for the Beowawe Justice Court will be from the northern boundary of the County, south to the east/west dividing line described by the JD Ranch road, south along State Route 278, then east along the Union Pass Road.

Chairman Benson called for public comment; there was none. Commissioner Ithurralde motioned to add Title 16, Eureka County Justice Courts, to the 2006 Eureka County Code, defining township boundaries and other matters properly related. Commissioner Bailey seconded the motion, motion carried 3-0.
