V. PUBLIC COMMENT AND DISCUSSION

A. Discussion: Public Comments

Troy Black voiced his opinion about what had been discussed when the previous plans of the park had been discussed, without a skate part. He said that the public did not want the skate park originally and if we keep doing this that we either will not get the park redone at all, or it will be drug out for a very long time. He added, "As you can tell I am opposed to the skate park, I would rather rearrange the horseshoe pits and things that we designed and get this back on track and get it back in front of the Commissioners and run it

through before we lose it.” Vice Chair Mason said, “To put your mind at ease that is why we are here.” He added this is why we called the emergency meeting to expedite this and get it pushed along.

Troy also added on his wife’s behalf, Angie Black, that he is concerned with the way she has been treated with getting the Community Center to put on the town activities. He would like to see the gals in the office and her get along or he will ask Angie to stop doing the activities. He said that he could speak with the gals in the office about it himself.

B. Action: Call for items to be placed on the next regular agenda.

Vice Chair Mason asked Chair Gann about the Goldies using the community center and Chair Gann said that they would have to apply with Vicki Drenon in the office just as everyone else does. He then asked her if the CVTAB sponsored an event for the Goldies would that need to be put on the next agenda, she said yes. Secretary Winters asked if this was something they would like on the Agenda for the January 26th meeting and Vice Chair Mason said yes. So it was decided to put on the next agenda for possible future events for the Goldies, asking the CVATB to sponsor those events.

V. OLD BUSINESS

A. Discuss, Approve, or Deny:

To reevaluate the sketch of the park plans from Eureka County Public Works.

Chair Gann said that we have a spot for a future skate park that is already a part of the plans. She continued that the way she understood it was that Juvenile Probation is looking at grants to put one in Eureka and Commissioner Page is looking for that up here as well. She said I don’t understand why we have to reapprove what has already been approved and we have a spot for it? Vice Chair Mason said we don’t, and he continued we just need to vote on it get it expedited and we can put the skate park in at the end of the project. Since it will be done in phases we can put the skate park off till the end. Chair Gann said again she is confused if we had already voted on this why we are bringing it back and voting on it again? Troy Black said, his understanding was that it was not in the plans and Commissioner Page wanted it so it was brought back on the table. He did not understand that it was in the plans. He looked at the plans and understood. Chair Gann said this is just what it will look like, you do not see the water system or utilities, and this is just as it appears.

Vice Chair Mason said the reasoning behind this is the Juvenile Probation is looking at getting funding, that spot on the sketch will be there for that purpose. They want to start with this year’s budget this spring and next year’s budget this summer, to coincide with the Road Departments building, to save money.

Vice Chair Mason made a motion to go forward with the park plans as proposed, and if they can get the grants for the skate park to go forward with it.

Chair Gann 2nd that motion, Chair Gann voted, “Aye,” for the record.

A. Discussion: Public Comments

Angie Black said we need to address the use of the Community Center. She said they had it rented for the entire day and she was not allowed in it until 2:00 pm. She said that many people have keys and those people come and go as they please, and it is supposed to be cleaned between each activity, yet it is dirty each time she goes to use the Community Center. She believes she is the only one that has to keep it cleaned. Vice Chair Mason agreed that it needs to be addressed and that he would talk with Ron Damele about this since it is his department that takes care of the Community Center. Vice Chair Mason said we need to get a calendar made and stick to it. Get the calendar that Vicki Drenon has and go from there. He continued we are an advisory board and we can make suggestions and see what arises from that.

Angie said that the Bingo has been such a big success we want to add dates. Vice Chair Mason said we need all the dates that is wanted for Bingo and other events and then we can get this narrowed down. He said he would personally work on the calendar, for the Community Center events.

Angie would like to know why we can't use the facility if it has not been booked, even if it has not been scheduled within the 30 days.

Vice Chair Mason reaffirmed that he will work on smoothing this over, he said he understands and will do what he can do, because if we don't iron this out we may lose the opportunity to use the facility.
