In accordance with Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 501, the Eureka County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife (CAB) primarily solicits and evaluates local opinion and advises the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners on matters relating to the management of wildlife. This includes providing recommendations on seasons and quotas for hunting, fishing, and trapping and on all regulations and other matters related to managing wildlife. The CAB also helps the county by working with landowners and land management agencies, including the NV Department of Wildlife, to pursue and complete projects that benefit habitat. The CAB consists of 3 members.

The board typically meets on the Thursday the week before the NV Board of Wildlife Commissioners meet and the meetings are typically at 4:30 p.m. throughout the year.
